Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,
The Eucharist is the “source and summit” of our lives, as St. John Paul II often reminded the world. In these three years of Eucharistic Revival, it would be good to look to the example of the Saints to learn about their devotion to Christ in the Eucharist, and how we can best emulate their devotion.

Saint Dominic: Saint Dominic, founder of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans), is commonly known for his zeal for souls as he spent countless nights praying for the salvation of souls. However, Dominic's early followers also recorded a more discreet practice of Dominic: they speak about the tears of their founder, not only when praying, but also when celebrating Holy Mass. Brother John of Bologna, an early friar, relayed that when he served at St. Dominic's Holy Masses, he would see tears stream down the saint's cheeks after he received Holy Communion. The simplicity of the tears of this great preacher reminds us that Jesus gives us a tremendous gift in the Eucharist: God Himself descends and takes His dwelling in the soul of man. Our response then should be one of gratitude, awe and reverence for the love Christ has for us: that He should give Himself to sinful man as food. As Dominic, we should always be thankful for Christ's gift to us in the Eucharist and be mindful of Whom we receive at Holy Mass.
