MAP Scores - Measuring Academic Performance

Students participate in NWEA - MAP testing three times a year and the results are used by educators as an indicator of academic growth and future progress. MAP assessment reports also help to inform instructional decisions.

This school year's 2023-2024 MAP testing results show OLC grades 1-8 scored higher than students across the country taking the annual MAP tests.
