In 1983, Father Ed was Lieutenant Ed Wills and experienced combat as Officer in Charge of the Construction Battalion detachment in Beirut, Lebanon. Upon his return to the U.S., he struggled with many of the classic symptoms of PTSD but didn't realize it. Eventually, he discovered his thoughts of violence, attraction to isolation, and lack of self-worth indicated a deeper problem. His physical body was okay, but his soul had been wounded. He began seeking God for healing guidance. Over several years, he developed healing prayer exercises using the principles of Ignatian imaginative prayer. He learned how regrets could be healed, destructive attitudes cleansed, and the freedom Christ promised could be realized.

Many who have not experienced combat have been hurt by the traumas of divorce, abuse, false teaching, grief, bitterness, and many other destructive forces that wound our souls and diminish our lives and relationships. If this is you, come walk with Father Ed as you begin your own healing journey.

Today, Father Ed Wills, a Catholic priest and author of several books, including *Lord, Heal My Wounded Soul*, shares his healing journey with many wounded souls. A former Anglican Priest, Father Ed is married with three children and seven grandchildren. He is retired from pastoral ministry but continues to write and offer retreats and preaching missions helping others to discover freedom and healing joy in Christ.
