DAY 1 Friday, June 6: Depart for Italy

Depart Denver International Airport on our overseas journey to Florence, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the flight.

DAY 2 <u>Saturday, June 7: Welcome to Florence!</u>

Arrive at Florence Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit Customs. Our luggage will be transferred to a comfortable touring bus, and we will be on our way to the Renaissance city of Florence. A stop will be made at Piazzale Michelangelo, one of the best viewpoints in Florence to appreciate the panorama of the city. Picture opportunity. Continue to our hotel for Check-in. If time permits, celebrate Mass before dinner.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Florence

DAY 3 Sunday, June 8: Hightlights of Florence

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll enjoy an orientation tour of the Renaissance city of Florence. Our local guide will take us to visit the **Accademia**, which houses the sculpture of "David" by Michelangelo. Then, continue to the beautiful Piazza Del Duomo to see the delicately patterned green, white, and pink Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore, crowned with Brunelleschi's magnificent dome; Giotto's Bell Tower; the Romanesque Baptistery of St. John with Ghiberti's exquisite bronze doors, which Michelangelo called the "Gates of Paradise". Continue to visit the 13th century Franciscan Church of the Holy Cross, which holds tombs of the greatest Florentine citizens. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Cross. Independent lunch.

Afternoon at leisure to further explore Florence. Perhaps you'll visit the Uffizi Palace, which houses what may be the most important collection of paintings in the world. You could also visit the Piazza Della Signoria; the famous shop-lined bridge, Ponte Vecchio; or its adjacent market. For those that would like to shop, this is the best time to look for leather, gold, or other Florentine souvenirs.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Florence.

DAY 4 Monday, June 9: Assisi | Sites of St. Francis & St. Clare
Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Florence for Assisi. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis. After Mass, our local guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare to view her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Independent lunch and time will be given to browse around.

This afternoon, we'll visit the Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. The tomb of Bl. Carlo Acutis is in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, the young Catholic from Italy who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B,D)

DAY 5 Tuesday, June 10: Saint Mary of the Angels Rome | Orvieto | Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Assisi to visit the nearby Basilia of St. Mary of the Angels which encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito which marks the spot where St. Francis died. See the statue of St. Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. If time permits, we'll walk to San Damiano, a favorite retreat of St. Francis and his followers. We'll walk along a trail between olive groves and sheep pastures to the old monastery. Here, St. Clare founded the Order of the Poor Clares and performed the most famous of the miracles. In 1240 on a Friday in September, she turned away an attack by Saracen soldiers who had broken into the convent cloister by showing them the Sacred Host. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels.** After Mass, we will be on our way to Orvieto, an Etruscan city located in the scenic region of Umbria. Independent lunch upon arrival.

We'll visit Orvieto Cathedral where the Eucharistic miracle of Bolsena is conserved. The miracle took place in 1263. After confirming the authenticity of the bloodstained corporal, Pope Urban IV instituted the Feast of Corpus Christi. We'll continue to Rome, the "Eternal City." Hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 6 Wednesday, June 11: Papal Audience | Papal Basilicas of Rome

After an early breakfast at our hotel, we will enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch.

The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" that is opened only during Jubilee years. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. The "holy heads of Ss. Peter and Paul" are enclosed in two ornate reliquries high above the main altar. It was founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. From there we'll pass by the Holy Stairs, said to be the steps on which Christ walked on His way to Pilate's palace. You can go up on your knees as thousands of pilgrims have done in reverently recalling the sufferings of Christ. Then, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY / Thursday, June 12: Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel | Walking tour of Historic Rome After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica. Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass we will visit one of the greatest art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End our morning with a more detailed guided tour of St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. Independent lunch.

After lunch, we'll go on a walking tour and experience the best of ancient Rome. Begin at Piazza di Spagna, one of the most famous squares in Rome. From the Fontana della Barcaccia (Fountain of the Old Boat), in the middle of the piazza, climb the famous Spanish Steps to the top. Continue to the Trevi Fountain and toss in a coin. Our next stop is outside of the Pantheon. Built more than 1800 years ago, the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Roman Empire. The name Pantheon refers to the building's original function as a temple for all the gods. When approaching the front of the Pantheon we can still see the original Latin inscription by Marcus Agrippa. Continue to the beautiful lively Piazza Navona, and the Church of St. Agnes, and Bernini's fountain. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 8 Friday, June 13: Imperial Rome | St. Paul Outside-the-Walls | Farewell Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the **Church of St. Peter in Chains** to see the original chains used to bring St. Peter to Rome, and the sculpture of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces. Continue to the ancient Roman Forum. See the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Independent lunch.

Continue our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls. Enter through the Holy Door. The basilica was built by Constantine in the 4th century. St. Paul is buried in the confessio of this church. Above his tomb are the chains that were used to imprison him prior to his martyrdom. These chains were placed in this prominent location in 2008. The main altar in the left transept is dedicated to the Conversion of St. Paul. The painting above this altar, completed by Vincenzo Camuccini, depicts this event. The tabernacle of the confession by Arnolfo di Cambio, an exquisite 12th-century candelabra by Vassalletto, a 13th century Byzantine stuyle apse mosaic of Chistors Pantokrator, and an attractive 19th century series of Papal Portraits in a frieze extending around the nave. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul. After mass we'll visit the Catacombs of St. Callixtus on the Appian Way near the Church of "Quo Vadis." These catacombs originated in the middle of the second century and are part of a cemeterial complex that occupies an area of 90 acres, with a network of galleries about 12 miles long and four levels deep. Visit the tombs of popes, martyrs, and half a million Christians in this subterranean complex.

Our farewell dinner, this evening, will be at a Restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and taste traditional Mediterranean cuisine with wine and music.

DAY 9 Saturday, June 14: Return from Rome

After early breakfast at our hotel, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day.
